Where's my funding? A review of the NIH Public Access Policy requirement, and an update on emerging policies of other funders

The National Institutes of Health (NIH) implemented a public access policy in 2008, requiring public access to publications produced from NIH-funded research. The majority of researchers manage to achieve compliance with the requirement, but non-compliant PIs can be subject to delays in funding or in proposal processing. This session will provide an overview of the policy, discuss how researchers and administrators can plan for compliance, and discuss some common problems and their remedies. We'll also discuss briefly what we know about the emerging policies of other major funders.
