Introduction to the new NIH ASSIST System

The National Institutes of Health (NIH) has developed a web-based system for use in preparing and submitting proposals. It is called the Application Submission System & Interface for Submission Tracking or ASSIST for short. This system can be used instead of Grants.gov for proposal submissions. One of the great features of ASSIST is its ability to check for eRA Commons errors and warnings before the proposal is submitted, eliminating the need for changed/corrected applications to be made via Grants.gov. You are also able to view the application, including attachments, as one PDF which is not possible prior to submission using Grants.gov.
