Changes in Human Subjects Regulations

On January 21, significant changes to the "Common Rule", the main federal regulation for the protection of human subjects, will go into effect. This presentation will provide a detailed examination of changes that will be most relevant to Cornell research, including: new exemption criteria, changes to the annual renewal requirements, an expanded mandate for single IRB review, and changes to informed consent. Some noteworthy provisions are triggered by the presence of federal funding, so those who support federally-funded research should find the information especially useful. In addition, we will discuss related changes in Cornell IRB practices and procedures, especially a new application form to be used for all levels of IRB review.
