Cornell has recently signed a Master Agreement with New York State that will facilitate contracting between sponsoring state agencies and Cornell's contract colleges. New York State research and public service funds represent a significant and reliable source of revenue for Cornell. Having in place a mechanism that streamlines contracting is an important achievement.
